

Make a Light catcher

- You'll need
- a picture mount or cardboard to make one
 - coloured acetate or cellophane
 - metallic card or mirror
 - scissors
 - double-sided tape
 - string

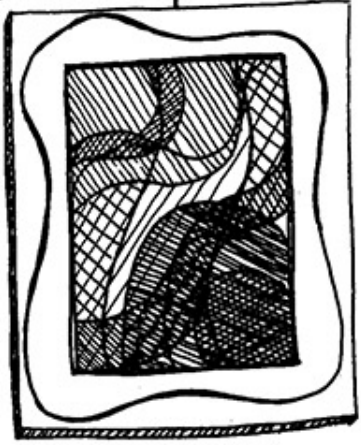
Select a picture mount or cut a hole in some cardboard to make your own frame.

Pick a colour of acetate to act as a base and cover the hole in the middle of your frame. Fix in place with tape.

Using different colours of acetate build up layers of colour. Experiment with overlapping shapes + mixing colours e.g. layering red over blue creates purple. Fix in place.

Decorate the frame front and back - use metallic card and mirror.

Now fix the hanging cord in place either by knotting or taping. Hang in a sunny window.



NOW you can:

Make a light box

- * Turn a large cardboard box upside down. Cut a hole to fit the light catcher + fix in place.
- * Under the box place a torch or fairy lights.
- * Turn off the lights!



Make a sensory den

- * Using blankets, duvets + pillows create a soft den in a darkened room.
- * Bring your light catcher + torch. Play casting coloured shadows inside the den. You might want to play some relaxing music too. Enjoy!
