When I arrive, I will go through an automatic door.



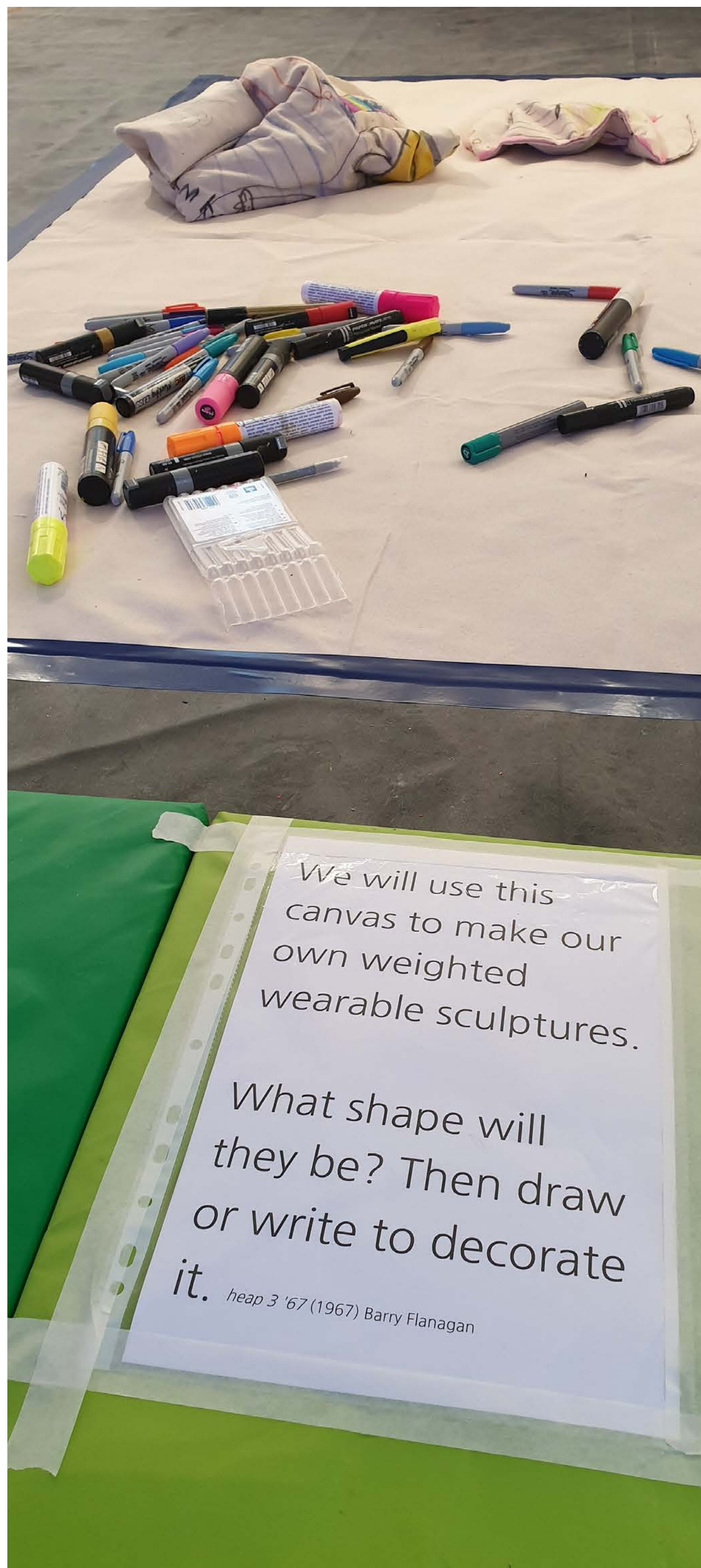
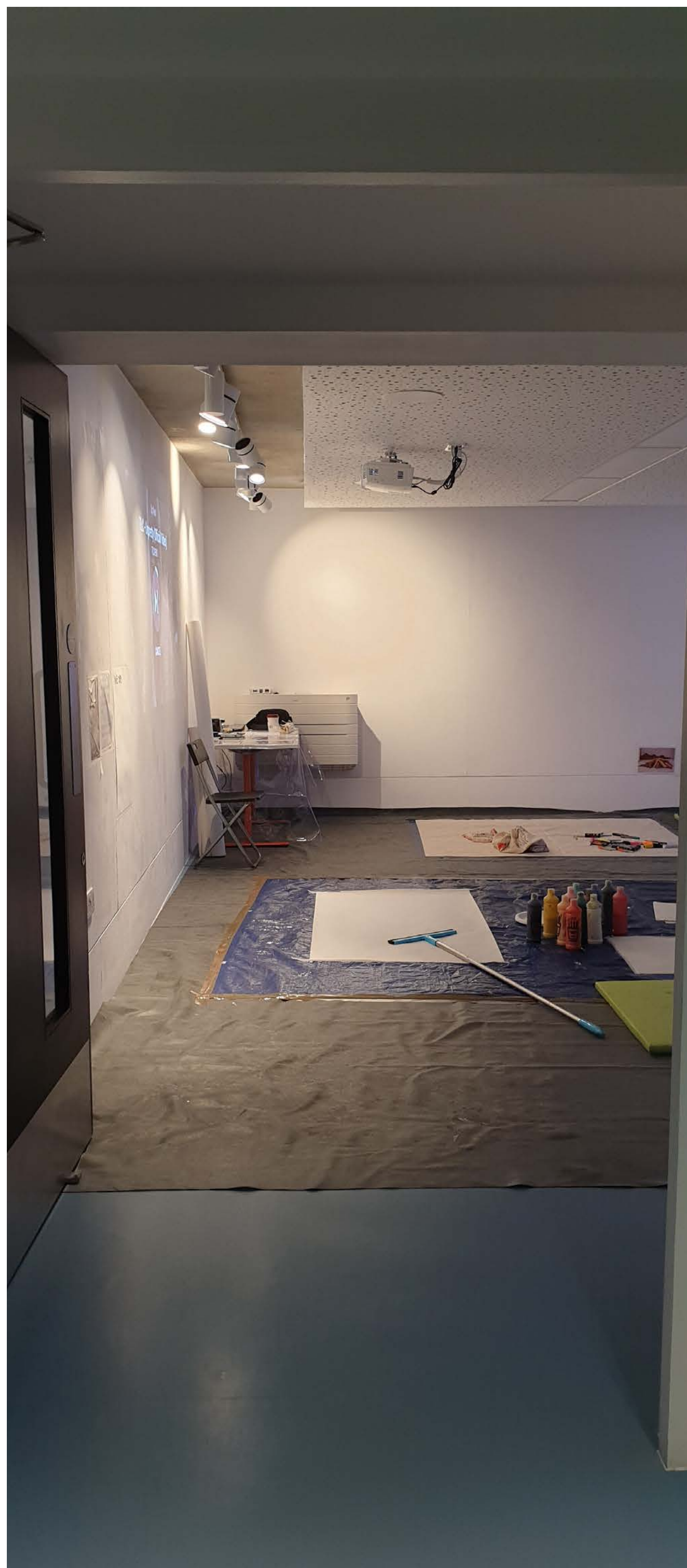
The reception of the gallery looks like this.
