Celebrating EXPLORERS event at Autograph



You will see photographs by artists Ernest Cole and C. Rose Smith on display






Autograph is located in East London.

The street and the building look like this.


The outside of the building will have the word Autograph on it.

You'll then go into the reception area, which looks like this.




People you'll meet



Visitor Assistants

Are in the galleries and at the front desk.

When you arrive they will say hello. If you have a large rucksack, a Visitor Assistant might ask you to leave it with them at reception. This is to protect the artwork in the galleries.



The event will take place in the exhibition space displaying Ernest Cole's works, located in Gallery 1 on the ground floor.

Photography will be hung on the walls and plenty of seating will be available.




There will be speeches at 5pm and project-related publications will be available for sale.

An optional creative activity will be taking place in the Education Studio which is located on the Ground Floor.



Refreshments will also be available in the studio.

Through the Education Studio is an outdoor yard that will be open.



If you would like to take a break at any time during your visit, you can go to Gallery 2 which is located on the second floor.

This will be a quiet space with low lighting, chairs, ear defenders, small weighted blankets, bean bags and sensory objects.






To get to Gallery 2 you can take the lift or the stairs to the second floor.
